IBEP Bowhunter Instructor Training by IBEP Master Instructor

Each of the EBF Member states nominates participants to be trained with the goal of becoming IBEP Instructors for the Bowhunters association of the member state. The training takes place over a weekend with the IBEP Master instructor Anders Geier . This training is meant to be the first step towards becoming an IBEP Instructor. The EBF does not have the ability to judge the participants capability of delivering IBEP trainings in such a short timeframe, therefore the decision to allow a participant to become an Instructor is delegated to the Bowhunting association of the member state.

The EBF strongly recommends that a participant should only get their IBEP instructor certificate once they have successfully held an IBEP training course together with an experienced instructor. The local Bowhunting association reserves the right to refuse handing over the IBEP Instructor certificate if a prospective instructor does not comply to this rule, or if the prospective instructor acts in a manner that is detrimental to the overall statement and purpose of the EBF:
